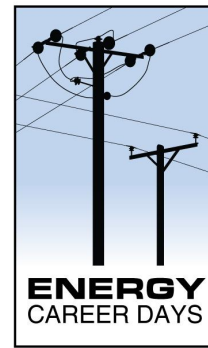

What is Colorado Construction Career Days (CCCD)?

CCCD is an industry-sponsored event for high school students, grades 10-12, to explore the various areas of construction—building, highway, engineering, architecture, and energy. Activities such as operating heavy equipment, a nail hammering contest, testing materials, making a wood case, wiring an electrical box, plumbing, surveying, apply technology, trouble-shooting equipment, fastening dry-wall, designing a simple electrical system, and safety equipment, offer students a glimpse of the diversity of careers in the industry.

Small groups of students are escorted by Group Leaders, construction industry volunteers, who serve as a source of information about the industry as well as guides to the activities.

What is the schedule?

High school guests will attend a morning session which includes lunch. Students are scheduled to arrive between 8:00 am and 8:30 am. After registration, they will participate in hands-on activities, try out equipment, have lunch and assemble for a fun time of awarding prizes—often including at least one iPod®

Who attends CCCD?

In 2010, over 1600 students and over 200 educators, representing 35 school districts attended the event, from the Metro area, including DPS, Jeffco, Douglas County, Cherry Creek, Adams, as well as outlying school districts.. Over 1,600 students, teachers and administrators participated in 2010. This year we again expect over 1,600 participants. We are also inviting school districts and private/charter/alternate schools throughout the state and State Workforce Centers.

Activities: Masonry, Drilling, Concrete Stamping, Carpentry, Electrical Splicing, Pipefitting.

Energy Career Days: Activities and equipment will be provided from the electric energy industry

Education & Industry Professional: Representatives from post secondary training programs, apprenticeship programs, and internships will be there to provide information and answer questions.
